Descriptions of Mission Ministries

Mission General Fund

The Presbytery's **Mission General Fund** includes support for:

- Small and rural churches,
- Blessing grants to churches,
- Matthew 25 activities and advocacy,
- Peacemaking activities and advocacy,
- Seminarian and Inquirer support, and
- Innovative Outreach programs.

In addition to the programs supported by the Mission General Fund, the Presbytery supports two growing ministries that need additional funding. Please consider a special gift to the Youth of the Presbytery and College-Age Young Adult programs

Youth of the Presbytery

This ministry provides for a part-time Presbytery Youth Director, sponsors quarterly Presbytery-wide activities for high school aged youth, including a summer youth mission trip, and organizes the Triennium trip every third year. These activities reinforce our reformed theology, connect our youth with other Presbytery youth in Utah and worldwide, and provide opportunities to serve our communities.

Young Adults/College Ministry

The Young Adult Ministry is committed to connecting college-age individuals with inclusive, supportive communities of faith rooted in reformed theology. Many existing college ministries in Utah do not align with our values. To authentically reach and support young adults while presenting a reformed, inclusive, and progressive Christian worldview, we must build our own spaces rather than rely on established interdenominational ministries.

This initiative is not primarily a recruitment effort for our congregations. While young adults are warmly welcomed in our churches, the core mission is outreach, support, and the cultivation of meaningful community. Our programs are intentionally inclusive and grounded in our theological tradition.

Each Young Adult Ministry is affiliated with a congregation, but gatherings take place in neutral, accessible locations—such as homes, libraries, and eventually on-campus facilities.
